

At the present time we estimate that the total fee will be \$600 which will include conference fee plus transportation. The deposit will be applied toward the total fee. We are planning to have 60 Arrowmen from our Lodge attending. In the past there has been a required ratio of 2 youth for every adult. If that is the requirement again, we would be forced to limit the number of adults. As final details are available, we will keep you informed. This can be a once in a lifetime experience for many Arrowmen.
