

Mark Twain National Forest in Missouri, June 7-14, where we'll be removing invasive species (that's stuff that doesn't belong there) to restore wildlife habitat.
Manti-La Sal National Forest in Utah, June 14-21, where we'll be removing some more invasive species.
Washington & Jefferson National Forest in Virginia, June 21-28, where we'll be doing some trail restoration work putting in water barriers, building a new campground and a new trail.
Shasta-Trinity National Forest in California, July 12-19, where trail maintenance on the Pacific Crest Trail is going to be the main project.

Bridger-Teton National Forest in Wyoming, July 26-August 2, where the crews will be removing old fence, opening up habitat for wildlife.

Sounds like a lot of work, eh? Well look at some of the fun stuff you'll get a chance to do, too:
River Rafting, Fly Fishing, Rappel-ling and Rock Climbing, Mountain Biking, Swimming, Hiking, Canoeing.
The opportunities are endless! Plus you'll be in some of the nation's most beautiful lands!

I'm not sure it's for me... How do I qualify? You'll need to be at least 14 years old by June 1, 2008, a

registered Scout and member of the Order. You also need to meet the Philmont weight to height guidelines and be in good physical shape. Youth and adult members are encouraged to participate!

All right, what's it going to cost me? The registration cost is \$250, and that includes food, insurance and activities that you'll have access to. It doesn't include the cost of transportation, though transportation will be available from nearby airports.
