
WINTER BANQUET CHICKEN RECIPE:

- 1. Chicken breast coat it in a seasoned flour of your choice
- 2. Heat up the sauté pan with butter and olive oil
- 3. Brown chicken on both sides, remove and set aside
- 4. Add more butter to the pan, add fresh sliced mushrooms, fresh chopped parsley, and fresh chopped garlic, and cook mushrooms until tender, quartered artichoke hearts, add salt and pepper to taste
- 5. Once the Mushrooms are cooked to your liking, add a small amount of cooking sherry to deglaze the pan. Then add heavy cream and reduce by 1/3.
- 6. Add grated Parmesan Cheese to your liking and place chicken back in sauce to reheat and finish cooking
